Świnoujście Offshore Terminal (ŚOT)

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All prices and amounts are stated excl. polish VAT and other public taxes and are subject to change without prior notice. Pricelists as well as port and terminal regulations are subject to change every year.

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1. Regulation and documentation

Immediately upon departure, the master or the ship's agent must submit the ship's manifest to ZPMSŚ and Świnoujście Offshore Temrinal (ŚOT) for the calculation of dues. The master or the ship's agent must also provide details regarding the ship, its passengers, and cargo in/out, etc. The information must be submitted to ZMPSŚ and ŚOT via e-mail address: swinoujscie.offshore.terminal@orlen.pl

2. Ship dues

All ships, vessels and other floating structures are required to pay ship dues for the use of the SOT and the fairways leading to the Port of Świnoujście. The obligation to pay ship dues rests with the ship. Ship dues are calculated on the basis of the ship's gross tonnage (GT) as stated in the ship's Tonnage Certificate.

The amount of port dues shall be determined on the basis of the vessel's gross tonnage (GT), in accordance with the valid International Tonnage Certificate issued under the International Convention on Tonnage Measurement of Ships, signed in London on 23 June 1969.
